The Court of Audit sends its 27<sup>th</sup> Report with comments to the Parliament of the French Community

The 27<sup>th</sup> Report with comments that the Court of Audit presents to the Parliament of the French community is divided into two parts.

The first part contains accounting and budgetary articles. At first, it comments on the approval of general accounts of the French Community and of several depending public services and entities. It then deals with the specific account audits.

In the second part, the Court of Audit reminds of some comments and recommendations it has made at the end of three audits focusing on the inventory of immovable assets (not within the educational field), on the new budgetary and accounting framework including the procurements by the French community universities and on the recognition of useful experience within the educational field.
