The Belgian Court of Audit presents its 29th Report with comments to the Parliament of the French Community



The 29th Report with comments that the Court of Audit sends to the Parliament of the French Community is made up of two parts.

The first part contains accounting and budgetary articles. First, the Court comments on the approval of the general accounts of the French Community and of several depending entities and public services. It also deals more specifically with the audit of the University of Namur's accounts 2013-2015.

In the second part, the Court reminds of some comments and recommendations it has made in the course of three audits: one focuses on the awarding and implementing of public contracts at the Catholic University of Louvain from the years 2013 to 2016, the second reviews the awarding and implementing of public contracts at Saint-Louis University in Brussels from 1st December 2013 to 31 December 2015 and the third delves into wages and allowances payments to the teaching personnel working within the compulsory education or the further education systems.
