Management of roadworks in the Brussels-Capital Region



The Belgian Court of Audit has examined how roadworks are managed in the Brussels-Capital Region through three major operators – Brussels Mobility, the public transport company STIB/MIVB and BELIRIS, in charge of building projects – in order to ensure that the works are adequately planned, managed and coordinated. Every year, 120,000 roadworks are carried out in the Brussels-Capital Region, 4,000 of which on a major scale.

The aforementioned operators do not always control the deadlines nor the costs. They have a good grasp of the state of the tram tracks, but not of the roads in general and even less of the underground.

Finally, while coordination of worksites is essential to limit their impact on local residents and on mobility, the current coordination process is not effective.
